Champlain Valley Landscaping Tour
2800 Lincoln Hill Road, Hinesburg, VT 05461

Join Paul Wieczorek for an evening tour of his gardens and nursery, which represent more than 25 years of plant collecting. The gardens are laid out informally to harmonize with their primarily woodland site. It is hopeful the rhododendrons and mountain laurel will not disappoint. The tour will also include a walk through Lincoln Hill Nursery, a one acre in-ground nursery located adjacent to the gardens.

Directions: From 89 take the Richmond exit; take Rte 2 east to the center of town. At the light turn right, follow the Huntington Richmond Rd to the Round church then go to the right continue on towards Huntington village, pass through the village and look for the Huntington Hollow Rd on your right. (white house right on corner) Turn right and continue for about a mile and take your first right onto Lincoln Hill Rd. The Nursery is 1.1 miles up. Mailbox on right says 2800 . House on left set down from road. Well landscaped.

From Rte 116 turn left from the north or right from the south) onto Hollow Rd between Starksboro and Hinesburg. Go about 4 miles pass the trailer park on your left. You will see a house with a white silo, soon after that turn left onto Lincoln Hill. Go a 1.1 mile up the hill. Mailbox on right (2800) brown house set down from rd on left, well landscaped.

Wetland Plants by Canoe & Kayak Workshop

Daniel Redondo, principal and senior Aquatic Ecologist at Vermont Wetland Plant Supply, will lead a canoe & kayak trip to explore the marshes of Winona Lake in Bristol, VT. You will learn about the native plants that thrive in deep water, shallow water, and the edges of the lake margin, and how you can use them in your backyard ponds and moist areas of your landscape. **Canoes or kayaks required, along with life-jackets. Binoculars recommended.**

Directions: Take Bristol Road and turn left (if coming from Monkton) onto Mountain Road. Take the first right onto Bristol Pond Road. You will see the state fishing access area.
