Any individual or organization with a principal place of business outside the State of Vermont and engaged in growing, designing, selling, distributing, installing and/or maintaining plants and landscape related products and services. (or) 3. Faculty and staff of educational, research, or government institutions with activities related to the horticultural industry.
Retired Membership \$55.00 Annual Fee - Any active member 62 years or older, who has retired from their principal place of business in Vermont and was engaged in growing, designing, selling, distributing, installing and/or maintaining plants and landscape related products and services. Retired active members, current in dues, are eligible to vote or hold office in the Association.
Student Membership \$31.00 Annual Fee - Any student actively pursuing a degree in the science of horticulture or landscape design and development.
